Coach's Report

As this was my third year as club coach I decided to approach pre season a little differently. Moving away from Kingsley to train and also have a trainer to get our fitness levels up proved to be very refreshing and those that did participate enjoyed the change. It is a shame we didn't have a better attendance at this early part of pre season, as I believe it was very beneficial.

Once we started training at Kingsley the numbers at training on Tuesdays and Thursdays increased and for most of the year the numbers and the intensity was fantastic. I believe this is where we are well in front of other clubs in our association. The way everyone trained in the early period set us up for the season and we got off to another great start.

As a club we performed extremely well. From a coaching point of view I was very pleased when the committee decided to introduce the "I" Grade because everyone got a game and no one missed out. To have all the grades except the A's in the finals is a remarkable achievement. Although as the club coach I was very disappointed in the Grand Final results from the B and D Grades. - Jarrold Heasman's rise as a super quick bowler
- Raj's all round performance in A's
- The D Grades one day final win
- The rise of B grade
- The performances of D and E to stay and end up on top at the end of the rounds
- The way G Grade played to a plan and won the Grand Final with ease

When I moved back three years ago I believed we would be back at the top within five years, we are nearly there. The influx of youth with their contributions both on and off the field has just been a fantastic injection to the club. Next year we will have an A, B, C, and D grade teams. I don't know if any other club has had this in the association, it is certainly a great achievement but it is going to be a very tough year for the incoming committee and Captains to maintain the winning combinations we have produced in the last three years. I believe all players will have to work harder in the pre season and the committee will have to recruit heavily to maintain competitive teams in all grades.

As I do every year I would like to thank my wonderful family who always miss out on many things in the cricket season. Thank you once again to my patient wife, Rob, for her encouragement, interest and commitment to the sport I love.

A Grade Captain's Report

Firstly well done to the club in general for having the majority of teams competing in the finals this year, the strength of our club as a whole through all our grades is a great asset to our club.

At the start of the season I was very confident of giving the A grade premiership a real shake as I thought the team we had would be a very competitive team in the competition.

However as it turned out we found ourselves in a pretty foreign position as the 2005 year ended with the spectre of relegation hanging over our heads. We lost half a dozen games by very small margins which put us under added pressure.

This year we really struggled to find any sort of rhythm on the field or at the selection table however we were constantly trying to find the right mix. With relegation looming this placed an added emphasis on selecting a winning team, whether this was also selecting the best team will remain to be a topic of conversation over the off season. By the half way point it proved difficult to select teams for the future of the club when our A grade position was in jeopardy.

I would have to say from a batting perspective that the 05/06 season would be labelled "The Year of Mediocrity" with none of the top of the batting order scoring more than 350. One of our greatest problems this year was trying to get more than two batsmen firing in any one innings, this will always lead to scores which are lacking. In the two dayers we also didn't bat out the 72 overs often enough, it's very hard to score runs if you are not out on the paddock.

Bowling wise I think we had a fairly normal year however we lacked penetration at times and did struggle to get enough wickets even though our pressure was good. The loss of Glenn through injury hurt us and hopefully he will be back keener than ever next year.

Our fielding was fairly good throughout the year we still dropped too many catches, however the injection of some young blood allowed us to lift our game which was refreshing.

Coming 7th in the A grade competition tends to sour the year dramatically but I think the future looks exciting with a number of young fellas coming through the lower grades who didn't get a chance in A's and also with the likes of Jared Heasman, Chris Bennett and Daniel Sadik who did get to show us their wares.

Highlights of the season:

- Tuggers catch in round 12 during the Day/Nighter against Greenwood. What a great grab, Ricky Ponting tried to emulate this feat afterwards but fell short when Ricky didn't have a broken rib and a punctured lung to show for his efforts.
